Fast Track: Register on-line, print and bring completed application, and copies of the required documents along with the original documentation for verification. (Copies cannot be accepted without seeing originals for verification)

Enroll after March 27, 2010 at the Early Learning Coalition of Alachua County's office during normal business hours, Monday- Friday (8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.); or during extended VPK registration office hours Monday-Thursday, April 12th -15th (8:00 a.m.– 6:30 p.m.).
